24. Competition rules (shortcut)

Riders on the marked loop in the field. First rider at the finish line will be a winner.
During the race riders may not shorten or change the route marked by the event host.
Riders not allowed to warm up at the race course during the race.
Technical assistance can only be given in the feed/technical assistance zones and acc. UCI Regulations (4.2.045-4.2.049).
Riders are ought keep fair play rules, vulgar words are prohibited, do not comply with the regulations and show any wrong behaviour to Commissaires and event host.
Riders starting at the race at his own responsibility.
Riders starting states that his health allows him to participate in the race.
Parents and guardians of a starting riders can not ride a bicycle with him or run with him during the race.
The decision as to whether the 80% rule is to be applied for race is made by the president of the commissaires panel after discussion with the organiser.
Any disputes which are not included in the Race Regulations will be resolve by Head Commissaire in consultation with Race Director

25. General Information

Riders are required to have a document confirming their identity when submitting to the race office and to sign a declaration of familiarization with the regulations.
The event host are not liable for damages caused to participants or third parties.
Competitors are required to start in stiff helmets and functional bikes.

Each participant agrees to the processing of his (or his mentee's) personal data provided during registration within the meaning of the Personal Data Protection Act of 29/08/1997 (Journal of Laws 2002.101.926) and the use of the image by the Warsaw Cup / PP XCO Organizer to promote and disseminate sport and physical culture, including publication of results, photos and reports from competitions in the press, on websites and industry guides.
